

# Mastro Installation

## Hardware requirements and recommendations:

1. Mastro only runs on Windows 7 (SP1) and higher (8.1, 10, 11) operating systems. Please note that Windows 7 and 8.1 are no longer supported by Microsoft and our support is limited on these operating systems.

For macOS users, it is possible to run Mastro using Windows virtualization software, such as Parallels Desktop: <https://www.parallels.com/fr/products/desktop/>

2. Mastro is designed for "1366 x 768" or "1920 x 1080" screen resolutions. At higher resolutions, objects may appear smaller. The "1920 x 1080" resolution allows you to increase the size of the wheels in the preferences. The minimum resolution is "1366 x 768".


(Note: The text size in the Windows display settings is normally 100%. It is likely that a larger size will affect the display of Mastro's graphic components. To check your screen resolution, right click on the Windows desktop and select the "Display settings" item.).

3. It is suggested to have 4 GB of RAM or more, on Intel i3 processor or higher. A computer with an SSD (Solid State Drive) is also recommended.
4. An internet connection is required for installation and license registration.

## Installation:

1. Disable your antivirus software. Some antivirus software such as Avast may prevent installation and block some updates on first start. In this case, allow the Mastro installer and Mastro itself in the antivirus settings or disable your antivirus for the duration of the installation and first boot. The Microsoft Defender antivirus does not require any special action. It is therefore not necessary to disable it.
2. Mastro requires the .NET Framework 3.5 SP1, a component of Windows. This framework may already be installed on your computer, if not you must install it first:

3. Following your "Download Mastro Standard" or "Buy Mastro Expert" request at <https://mastroapp.com>, you should receive a download link by email. Depending on the version:
  - **Mastro Standard:** Click on the installer download link (in the email). Once the download is complete, run the installer and follow the steps until the installation is complete.

- **Mastro Expert:** Click on the installer download link (in the email). Once the download is complete, run the installer and follow the steps until the installation is complete.

The first time you start Mastro Expert, you will be asked to enter the license information that was sent to you in the email (email address and license number). We recommend that you copy and paste the license number rather than retype it, to avoid errors. Please keep this information in a safe place.



Note that at start up, Mastro will do some local updates and will take some time to initialize the application's default values.

## Notes:

- **Windows 7:** For Windows 7 users, be sure to upgrade your operating system to Windows 7 SP1. For more information: <https://www.techhit.com/how-to/install-.net-3.5.1/windows7/>. - **Duration of licenses**
  - **Mastro Standard** is free and cannot be sold.
  - **Mastro Expert:** Currently, the purchase of Mastro Expert gives you a lifetime license. As long as the Mastro team can update Mastro you will be eligible for all available updates. We may eventually sell licenses limited in time or to a certain major version, but this would have no impact on previously sold unlimited licenses.
